Newsletter - nothing new but a reminder to have all posts for the newsletter by midnight on the 15th. Sunshine cards - none sent.

Membership - new members will receive a pin and if you lose yours or want another pin, you can buy one. **Recurring Business**

Hints for the month: Lois Keith shared a rotating cutting board; Sheila Cross shared a rolled up magazine (form many days past) with a sleeve on it, to iron seams. She shared that she uses a block to press seams, too. Last, Sheila shared a Judy Hopkins Scrap Master ruler. Jan Kuhn shared "marty's Choice" batting tape which she used on a quilt and she found it useful, (available at Nancy's Notions or online). In April, Madonna Belval, Mary Sargent, and Martha Corey will be sharing a hint.

Library - there are 357 books, 3 new ones. Please remember to give her at least 24 hours notice for availability. **Sunshine Quilts** - no quilts given out in the last month. There is a workday on Saturday, March 22 from 9am - 3pm. New quilt kits will be available soon. Please remember to put your name in when you hand in a charity quilt so your name can be added for the drawing.

Block of the Month - Sally collected 37 squares and Jane Langdell won the squares. Next month the pattern is Rocky Road - available online at the Common Threads website if you were not at the meeting.

Program Committee - In April, Marion will be sharing an appliqué method. The beginner's class went well garnering 3 new members and another youngster to join our guild. The next class will be on March 15 at the Johnson Town Offices from 9 = 12. Jane Frenke Trunk Show has been penciled in for September 4 = 6. Her website is WWW.Fiestafibers.com. She uses curved piecing. The first class would focus on dyeing material and she provides a kit = fee - materials - dyes and material. The second class would be to make a quilt with dyed materials or your own materials. There is an article on her techniques in March 2014 issue of Quilters Newsletter. Sharon shared that the Franklin County Quilter's Guild Quilt Show will be April 5-7. On Saturday the show is open 9am - 5pm and on Sunday 10am - 3pm. there is free admission. An appraiser will be available by appointment. **Old Business**: Marion has offered to make the Raffle quilt for the next show (2015). The guild will pay for the materials - Shirley Duso made a motion to accept. Sharon seconded. The guild passed the motion. Marion offered to have the material at cost for the guild. She showed a sample square with blues (by the way a beautiful design). **Tee shirts** - Andrea found many other vendors who sell tees. She chose 3 top contenders. It looks like it will cost about \$15 for a short sleeve v neck tee, \$20 for a long sleeve tee, and \$35 for a sweatshirt with a square bottom - a hoodie is available. Set up costs are from \$25 to \$100, silkscreen or embroidery and a minimum of 0 - 6 pieces. She will set out samples so we can see the qualities of the materials.

Antiques and Uniques in Craftsbury on July 12 - the question was do we want to keep our space along the fence and sell either charity quilts, cookbooks and/or tickets for the Raffle Quilt (if Marion can get enough of the quilt finished). sharon made a motion to keep the space, Annie Morgan seconded and the guild passed the motion. Shop Hop - Flo shared it will occur from March 21 - 30. the shops will all be open from 9am - 6pm except for the 30th (open till 3pm). Passports are \$7. there is a quilt journal, too. Shops may have snacks, there will be door prizes, and prizes. There will be a free pattern available at each shop. If you have passport stamped by at least 6 shops you are eligible for raffles. Material is on sale now for \$11.60 yd - a 1/4 print with maple leaves.

Common Threads Sunshine Quilts size guidelines

Hospital birthing center 38" x 38" up to 40" x 40" Lap quilt in all themes; men, women, children 42" x 50" Twin 65" - 72" wide x 90" - 100" long Full/Queen 90" - 92" wide x 98" - 104" long These are approximate sizes.

The size that we use the most of right now is the lap size

We need 8.5" and 4" squares cut to make kits for Sunshine quilts in any quantity. (A lap quilt uses 35 of the larger squares and 70 of the smaller.)

Please remember to put your name in finished kits, tops and quilts that you bring in so that you are eligible for the prizes - also, if you use your own fabric for a quilt top just write 'my stash' so you get the extra credit. Thank you!
