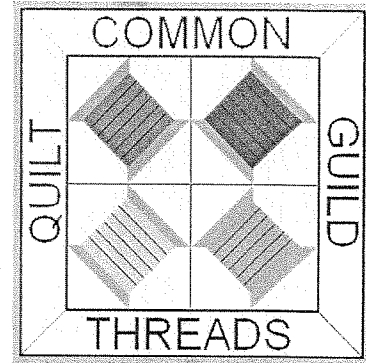


# Common Threads Quilt Guild
