Congratulations to Andrea for planning a successful Quilt Trip. Where are we going next?!

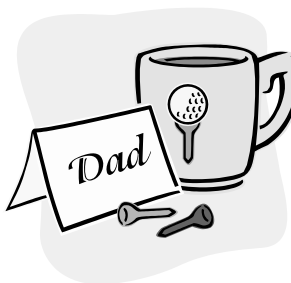
Show & Tell was wonderful as always and kudos to the "Bag Parade" and the Bag Demos.
