I think spring is finally here! I have been out gardening and cleaning up my yard and discovered a white trillium in the woods! It is so pretty.

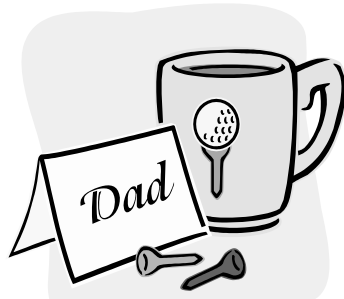
I want to thank Lisa Vilord for running the meeting last month. I am sure she did a great job despite the last minute program cancellation.

### Two Colors

Off White and Blue or any primary colors

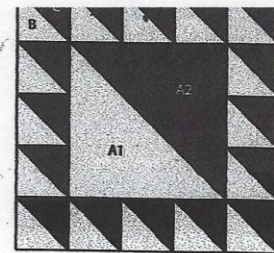
### Cut

Off White - 1" - 6 7/8" square - cut on diagonal

8 - 2 7/8" squares

Blue - 1 - 6 7/8" square - cut on diagonal

8 - 2 7/8" squares



Basket  
10" x 10" Block

### Sew

- 1) Layer blue and white 2 7/8" squares and mark on diagonal
- 2) Sew 1/4" either side of mark
- 3) Cut on mark - iron and trim corners - makes 16 blue/white squares
- 4) Sew 1 large white triangle to large blue triangle forming a large square
- 5) Join 3 small squares - twice - see figure 2 -
- 6) Sew these to each side of large blue/white square - watch directionality - See figure 3
- 7) Join 5 small squares - twice - See figure 4
- 8) Sew these to top and bottom of Figure 3 - watch directionality
