Two Colors

Off White and Blue or any primary colors

Cut

Off White - 1" - 6 7/8" square - cut on diagonal

8 - 2 7/8" squares

Blue - 1 - 6 7/8" square - cut on diagonal

8 - 2 7/8" squares


Sew

- 1) Layer blue and white 2 7/8" squares and mark on diagonal
- 2) Sew ¼' either side of mark
- 3) Cut on mark iron and trim corners makes 16 blue/white squares
- 4) Sew 1 large white triangle to large blue triangle forming a large square
- 5) Join 3 small squares twice see figure 2 -
- Sew these to each side of large blue/white square watch directionality See figure 3
- 7) Join 5 small squares twice See figure 4
- 8) Sew these to top and bottom of Figure 3 watch directionality
