Court House Steps

Cut:

- 1) 1 2 ½ inch square Dark Green
- 2) 4 light 1 1/2 inch strips
- 3) 4 dark strips
- 4) Sew 2 dark strips to top and bottom of dark green square
- 5) Sew 2 light strips to sides of first rectangle created
- 6) Continue building square with remaining strips
