Message from the President

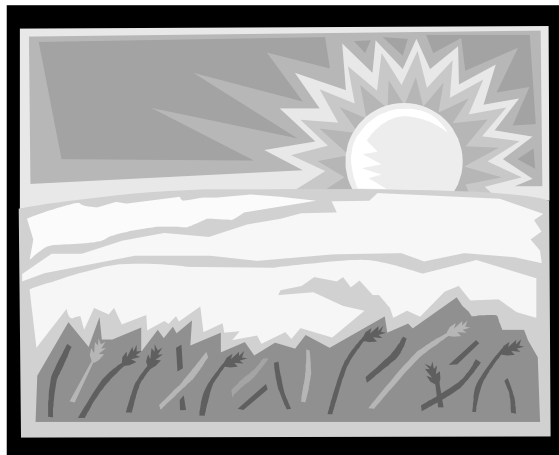
Greetings everyone,

Sew and Tell: Five people shared their pieces - always inspiring.

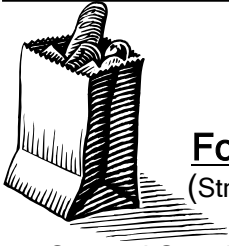
