


12" finished quilt block 8" finished quilt block




12" finished quilt block

*All seam allowances are ¼" unless noted otherwise	




3—6	Fabrics for Flying Geese units
	You can use one to four different fabrics for the flying geese units. For this example I will assume you are using 4 different fabrics. For each different fabric, cut 1 square 4 ½" and bisect on both diagonals, yielding 4 triangles of each fabric




8" finished quilt block




3—6	Fabrics for Flying Geese units
	You can use one to four different fabrics for the flying geese units. For this example I will assume you are using 4 different fabrics. For each different fabric, cut 1 square 3 ¼" and bisect on both diagonals, yielding 4 triangles of each fabric
